On the Mondays of May 19<sup>th,</sup> and June 2<sup>nd</sup>, at 5:00 PM, we will have "quiz nights" at The Black Anchor Pub to raise money to assist the youth in this parish in their pilgrimage to Rome this summer as part of the Jubilee year in the global church. *It is time to get your team together and enter it into the competition*. - 7. Next Thursday is the first day of May, the Month of Mary. We will have the rosary every day at 9:00 PM here at Santiago and led by the various groups in the parish in Portuguese. On Saturdays, the rosary will begin at 5:00 PM and led by those in Catechesis. On Sundays it will be at 6:30 PM at the Igreja do Carmo church and led by the Carmelites Order and the Brotherhood. The rosary will also be prayed in other communities, such as at the churches in Santa Luzia, at 4:00 PM and Cabanas, at 6:30 PM.
- 8. In May there will also be changes to some of the Mass times for Portuguese Masses. At Igreja do Carmo, the Sunday Mass will move to 7:00 PM and in Cabanas the Wednesday Mass will also move to 7:00 PM. At the Igreja de Nossa Senhora da Conceição, the Saturday Mass will move to 7:30 PM.

- 9. We are also asking people to sign up to take part in the pilgrimage to Rome-Italy. The tour is in Portuguese. Currently, the number of people registered is not enough for us to go ahead with this event. If we do not reach the minimum number by the end of May, we will cancel the pilgrimage.
- 10. Please leave the church today promptly and quietly as there is a Portuguese Mass immediately following. Thank you.
- 11. The youth of the parish will be selling cakes and pastries, as you exit, to raise money for their pilgrimage to Rome this summer.
