- 3. On Monday, December 2nd, at 8:30 PM, in the Church of Santo António, we will begin Bible School (in Portuguese). Everyone is invited to take part. Bring your Bible and notebook.
- 4. On Saturday, December 7th, we will hold a Pastoral Council in the morning.
- 5. On Sunday, December 8th, the 2nd Sunday of Advent, we will celebrate the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, in Conceição, with Mass at 2:30 PM, followed by a procession in the city.
- 6. We have started celebrating Eucharist in the Church of Cabanas, in the area of the mortuary chapel. We have Eucharist there every Wednesday at 6:00 PM.
- 7. As you leave today, considering buying a piece of cake or pastry from the youth of the church. They are raising money for a pilgrimage to Rome.
- 8. Confessions during Advent at the Church of Santiago will be on the 20th of December from 7:00 to 9:00 PM and on the 21st of December from 10:00 AM to 12:00 Noon.
- 9. Each Sunday during Advent, we welcome one family and their children to light the Advent candles immediately prior to Mass. Please see one of the greeters if your family would like to volunteer.
- 10. Restoration work on the side doors of the church is now underway. We hope that the new doors for the main entrance will also be a reality within the next few weeks. Bishop Dom and Fr. Miguel offer their thanks to you for the help we have received for these improvements to our Church.
